June 7-9th Eco Garden build-up--COMPLETED

Last weekend Members of MBSR and spouses went down to The School Tierra y Libertad in Primo Tapia, area of Cantamar Baja California. We purchase at Home Depot and other local stores, such as the local Nurseries our materials and plants to build the garden. Fortunately for us, all we needed, was purchase there! I want to thank Stephanie and Hayden (Environmental Committee) for providing an excellent list that guided us through the process of building the ECO garden. We build 5 vegetable boxes on the school grounds.

The local wood supplier cut the wood and they deliver it for a fee to the school. We also secured the "good" soil from a nursery close by. We purchase plants, seeds and trees. We borrowed some tools from our members. We also painted the playground with stain so the wood will last longer.
