1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Club members met with the leadership of Project C.U.R.E. at its facility in Woodridge, Illinois, and learned about its operations and needs. Club members donated funds for the group's "Kits for Kids," which provide personal hygiene and basic "medicine cabinet" items. If a child gets hurt, families might have to travel a long distance by bicycle, bus or on foot to receive care at the nearest medical clinic. Developed with volunteer Pediatricians and Nurses, Kits for Kids give parents in developing countries the supplies they need to provide basic care at home. Club members also acquired used wheelchairs from an assisted living facility that closed, cleaned them, and delivered to Project C.U.R.E. to be used for its donations of medical equipment as needed.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?      Six

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.      Collected and cleaned used wheelchairs that were donated to Project C.U.R.E., and raised and donated funds for the "Kits for Kids" project.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?      Roughly 50 families and individuals.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?      Provision of medical kits helps the children in those families grow up healthier.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?      Project C.U.R.E. collects and distribute the kits and medical equipment.
