Club members volunteered at Loaves and Fishes, a local food pantry and social services provider that now feeds 10,000 people each week. Rotarians sorted donated food, so it was organized for the free onsite food market and to fulfill online ordering. We also helped fill boxes of food (dairy, produce, frozen meat, dry goods) for drive-through pick-up. Club members also provided funding for food to help restock the food pantry.
