Who were the beneficiaries? For many students a TheaterWorks field trip is their first exposure to theatre and the performing arts outside of their schools. We perceive many notes from students and teachers about the importance of these opportunities. Our Christmas Carol field trips for example, are often the perfect blending of what is being taught in the classroom and connecting it to art. Teachers share with us that students sometimes "don't get it" until they are able to see the words they've been reading in the book come to life on stage.


