1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? **The Rotary Club of Channahon-Minooka (RCCM) worked with one of our school partners, Channahon School District 17 (CSD17). They serve approximately 1,400 K-8 students in the community. Rotary members worked with school officials on an assessment of how we could help support student needs. Families of some students cannot afford backpacks for their students to carry books and computers to and from school and during the school day. CSD17 seeks external funding to provide backpacks to these students.**
2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? **3**
3. What did they do? **RCCM Members worked with CSD17 officials to determine needs and select the provision of backpacks as a project that would provide the highest and best value to students in need. Because of student confidentiality we were advised that we could not be involved directly in providing the backpacks to students.**
4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? **27 CSD17 Students received backpacks.**
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? **The backpacks have an expected 3-4 year life expectancy, used by the students thought those school years.**
6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? **CSD 17. They specified, ordered, and delivered the student backpacks to students who met financial need guidelines.**
