1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? The Agents of Influence video game was created by Rotarians from the Rotary Club of Newport Beach. It is a non-partisan game to combat "truth decay" by teaching young players to think critically and seek the truth using the popular medium of a video game created for this purpose.

In November 2021, Anahita Dalmia gave a presentation to the LNRC regarding the Agents of Influence video game project. In May 2022, the LNRC approved of submitting a District Grant application for the Agents of Influence project at the request of 2021-2022 Club President Eileen Gomez. In July 2023, Anahita met with 2022-2023 Club President Chandra Chell to discuss further details about providing pursuing a district grant and which schools in Laguna Niguel and within Capistrano USD might be appropriate for receiving the funds for the project.

In early 2023, Anahita was provided with a list of high schools and middle schools in Capistrano USD along with the contact information for each school principal. She eventually determined the Carl Hankey TK-8 Academy in Mission Viejo would be willing to accept the unrestricted license during the 2023 – 2024 Rotary year.

In January 2024, the invoice from Alterea Inc., Anahita's company was received and the LNRC Treasurer issued a check to pay this invoice.

In January 29, 2024, Anahita attended our weekly club meeting to give an updated presentation regarding the Agents of Influence project. She was presented with a \$3000 check for the project.

On April 22, 2024, Anahita Dalmia had a meeting with several of the Social Studies Chairs from the Capistrano Unified School District. Of those in attendance, Carl Hankey TK-8 Academy teacher Kathryn Beitz indicated that she was interested in implementing the project immediately in her 8th grade social studies classroom.

On May 23rd, LNRC Past President Chandra Chell and Treasurer Marilyn Crary went to Carl Hankey TK-8 Academy to meet with teacher Kathryn Beitz and her Social Studies class of eighth grade students. They spent the entire classroom period with the students to observe them playing the game, - most for only the second time. They also spent time discussing the different situations presented within the game and how they moved and advanced through each module as certain decisions were made.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Chandra Chell Of Laguna Niguel Rotary and Anahita Dalmia of the Rotary Club of Newport Beach

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Anahita Dalmia is one of the two creators of the game. She pursued finding a middle school in within the Capistrano Unified School District to accept the LNRC's gift of the unrestricted license for the game. LNRC Past President Chandra Chell obtained board approval and funding for the project. Both Chandra and Treasurer Marilyn Crary also met with the teacher and her 8th grade class of 20 students.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Approximately 63 eighth grade students from Carl Hankey TK-8 Academy in Mission Viejo would benefit immediately from the implementation of this project. Going forward, each 8th grade social studies class at Carl Hankey Academy would benefit in perpetuity.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

These students will learn critical thinking and decision-making while engaging in this game with the goal of this process translating to a lifelong learning experience to prevent the spread of misinformation.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Capistrano Unified School District was very cooperative in allowing implementation of the Agents of Influence Video Game in its respective middle schools. To date, two middle schools have implemented the video game and several others have shown interest.
