Josh the Otter:

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries

On March 19, 2023, members of the club presented the water safety program, the Josh the Otter, to students in grades Toddler to 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade at Palisades Elementary School in Dana Point. The presentation will included interaction with the Josh the Otter (a member in a mascot costume), the reading of the Josh the Otter book, giving out books and coloring books to students, and teaching the students the Josh the Otter song. There was also a discussion on water safety.

On May 29, 2023, members of the club presented the Josh the Otter program to students in grades Toddler to 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade at RH Dana Elementary School. The program was similar to the above.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? We had 6 Rotarians participate in the project.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. The Program includes Rotarians passing out books and packets, interacting with students, discussing water safety with students, and dressing up in the mascot costume to get students excited about water safety.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? At least 300 students along with students' teachers, parents, and siblings will benefit from this program.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Because of an increase in awareness on water safety, there should be fewer drownings in kids ages 2-11 within the Dana Point Elementary School populations. Literacy should also improve as the books that are distributed are part of a fun activity.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Josh the Otter / Joshua Collingsworth Foundation provided the program and materials.
