Your gift contributed to the launch of the Liberty School programming for students at Cabrillo Elementary. In the 2023-24 school year, our staff, partners, and teaching artists have had the opportunity to meet and engage with 84 Cabrillo youth, ranging from $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ grade — to provide access to meaningful exposure in a multidisciplinary arts experience that is unique in the San Diego region.

In February, it was a joy to present to the club and share the Liberty School story. As you know, Liberty School's primary focus is to integrate the arts into the school curriculum, incorporating a unique approach to education that fosters creativity and incorporates student's learning styles and abilities. To that end, the teaching artists provide instruction through experiential opportunities in a variety of art forms.

Anecdotal evidence and survey responses have reinforced that the Liberty Station experience positively impacts students' social-emotional learning and the cultivation of a growth mindset. Other impact areas we've seen include:

- Positive changes in student attendance and behavior
- Improved academic performance of students
- Increased class participation and improved ability to focus and follow instructions






