3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

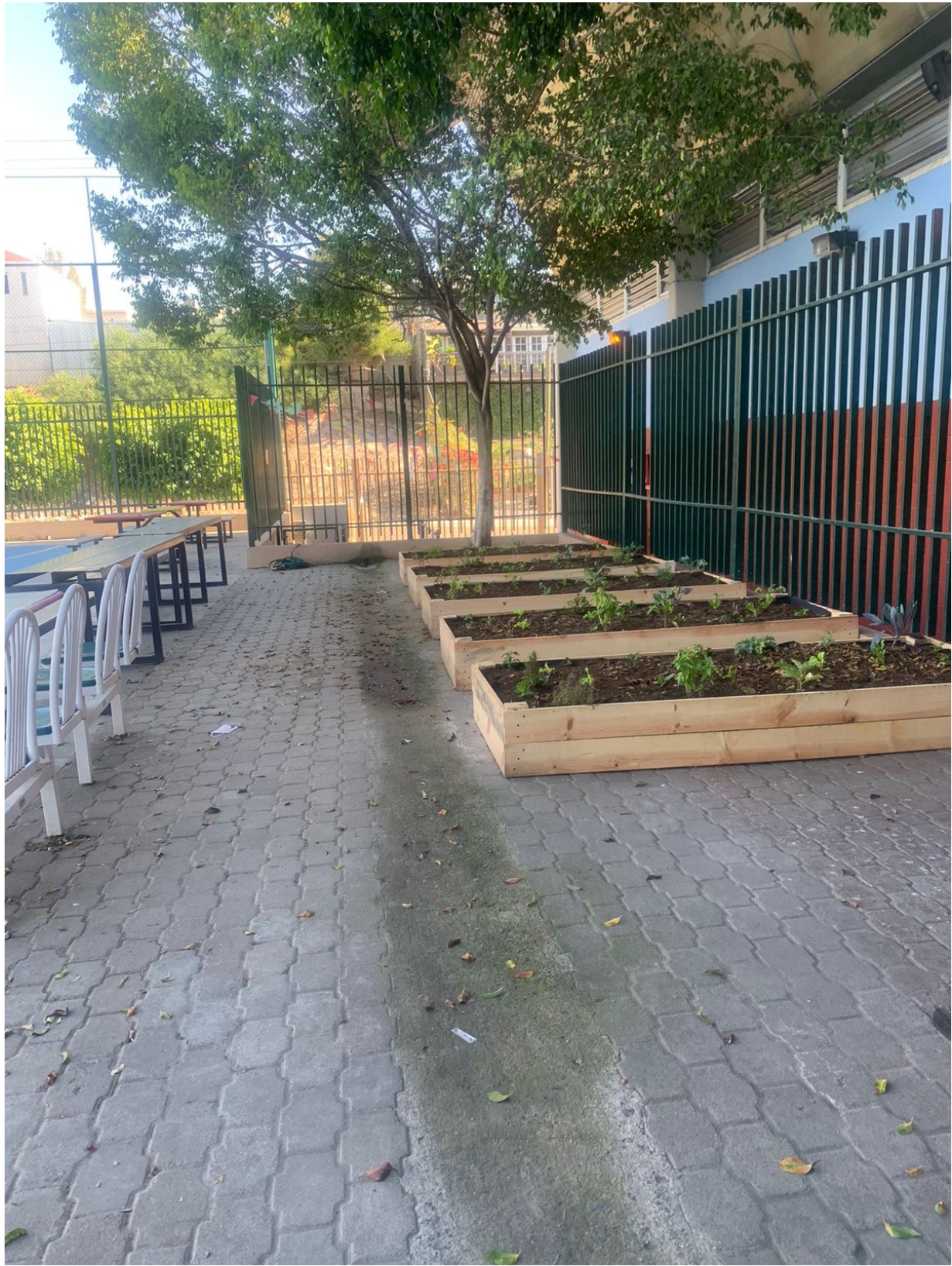


