- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?  
 Rotarian Linda Yates ordered paper supplies and hand made over 1200 notes of cheer that were blank inside. Rotarian Rachel Ossyra prepared instructions for card writers. The notes of cheer were divided up among the 6 districts attending Midwest PETS March 1-3, 2024. Each PETS attendee was given 2-3 cards to write notes of cheer appropriate for a senior in a nursing home. The cards were collected and then divided among the 6 districts to distribute to nursing home residents in their districts in the Spring.

 Over 500 Rotarians participated.
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples.  
 The Rotarians created the cards by hand, wrote notes of cheer and distributed the cards to local nursing homes in their districts.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?  
 Over 1200 senior residents in nursing homes benefitted.

 Improvement of mental health of seniors by knowing people in the community are thinking and caring about them. Rotarians were encouraged to continue this simple project in future.
