A 20x10 ft. area in front of the church was prepared for a native Plant Monarch Garden. St. John's church has an active environmental focus and has converted much of its land to vegetable and Native Plant Gardens. DGC Sprouts is a youth garden club that is sponsored by Darien Garden Club. St. John Partners with the garden club by providing the space on the grounds and water support for the learning garden.
