CHANGE THE PATH OF IDAHO STUDENTS THROUGH THIS IMPORTANT INTERVENTION PROGRAM



Everyday Leadership is a collaborative effort created by the Treasure Valley Family YMCA to provide low-income 5th and 6th grade youth with the skills and confidence they need to graduate from high school and attain post-high school educations. This intervention program reaches children before low self-esteem and poor academics can have a negative impact.

PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

- 13 bi-weekly afterschool sessions
- Lessons on leadership, teamwork, communications, cooperation, conflict resolution and decision making
- Community service projects

ACHIEVING RESULTS

Through the Everyday Leadership program, families and teachers have noted improvements in participating students. This includes:

- 87% of participating students improved their grades above a 3.5 GPA
- All students increased their grades above a 2.5 GPA
- Behavioral incidences declined by 65%
- Families reported participants adopting leadership skills
- Educators report that participants positively influencing the behavior of other students
