1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The annual Children's Outreach Concert The Whittier Regional Symphony took place on May 12, 2025, at the Vic Lopez Auditorium at Whittier High School. Approximately 2,000 students from Whittier area elementary schools attended.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

We usually assist with the unloading of school buses that bring the students to the auditorium and with the reloading after the concert. Approximately 2,000 students and their teachers.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Introduction of students to orchestral music leading many to take up instruments in middle and high school. Music education is generally understood to enhance other areas of education. Our club also has a vested interest in music education in the schools as our annual fundraiser, the Battle of the Bands, is made possible by the music programs in our area's high schools.

The Whittier Regional Symphony Association organizes the Children's Concert as a part of its yearly free concert schedule for the Whittier public. Our contribution is directed to the transportation of students.
