Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)?

\$4,000 was given to District 5495 to fund RYLA Scholarships. RYLA is meant for ages 12-18 according to Rotary International

14 students, ages 15-16, from Sedona Red Rock High School attended SR RYLA at Camp Pinerock \$2,000 was given by our club to fund scholarships for this age group at a cost of \$450/student.

Another \$2000 was given by our club to fund scholarships to JR RYLA at Camp Wamatochick for students ages 12-14 (finishing 6th grade to finishing 8th grade) at a cost of \$350/student.

JR RYLA Camp Wamatochick June 11-14, 2025, Prescott, AZ USA

Who were the beneficiaries? Students from Sedona Red Rock JR & SR High school. JR RYLA also included students from other schools in Sedona and the Verde Valley area of Arizona.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? At least 8

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. 6 Rotarians reviewed applications to SR RYLA and participated in interviews of all candidates. 2 Rotarians were bus chaperones and 1 Rotarians was a Counselor at the SR RYLA Camp - several others visited to observe.

3 Rotarians participated in Parent/Student information night for JR RYLA and a 4th Rotarian will help with training of the JR counselors for JR RYLA

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Each student and their families benefit. For each scholarship, at least 3 people benefit. Sedona Red Rock High School staff and administration love this program which is life changing for the the students who attend and affects the ethos of the

school. Parents of the students thank us profusely for the difference it has made in their children's lives. Some even said "I got my child back after covid"

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Life- changing for the students in terms of their self confidence, social and mental health.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? SR RYLA is supported by a collaboration of 3 Rotary Clubs in Sedona. JR RYLA has been primarily a project of the Rotary Club of Sedona.
