1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? This is an ongoing project for our club that puts age appropriate books each month in the hands of children between the age of birth and their 5th birthday. If the child is enrolled for the entire time they will receive 60 books.

When (dates) and where (city, state and country) did project activities take place? We started the program in January of 2021 and it is still going today. Our first month we had 127 children enrolled and the monthly billing was \$266.70. Last month, we had 1242 children enrolled and monthly billing was \$2789.60. I have attached a copy of the monthly spreadsheet for our review.

Who were the beneficiaries? Currently, 1242 children between the ages of birth and 5.

- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 10, But there are 2 that really make it happen.

- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Close to 2000. Students are added when funding allows and deleted only when they leave the program because the move out of the zip code of the program or graduate out when they turn 5 years old. Each child is fully funded through their potential time in the program.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Children that read books or even just look at the pictures have more neuron growth during their formative years. Additionally, the books are a pretty permanent item which are often shared with other members of the family... like younger siblings or sitting with parents and reading.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? DPIL is the partner that sources and distributes the books. We are the partners who raise funds and get children enrolled in the program.
