- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
Monies were sent to District 4700 from District 6450 in conjunction with monies raised at the Central States Rotary Youth Exchange summer conference. This was sent to support the on-going relief effort by rotarians in southern Brazil, supplying food, medical, and physical labor cleaning up from the Flooding that occurred earlier in the summer/late spring.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? From the collection end approximately 50-75. From the receiving end 100-200 received and were used to help thousands in need of help.
- What did they do? Mud removal, medical clinics set up to monitor disease and offer assistance since local hospitals were closed, food service and water distribution is being done on a daily basis.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Thousands of local residents affected by the flooding.
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The hope is for people to return to what they have lost. For those who are unable to return, a new beginning will hopefully be available.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Rotary District 4700 took care of distributing the funds.
