 This grant was used to assist in the on-going counseling and therapy groups that help women who have suffered from immense traumas during their journey to the Border and the Chicago as the flee their country of Venezuela. Managed by the Illinois Venezuelan Alliance

- What did they do? Administer and participate in the ongoing therapy as described above. Groups being formed as migrants arrive in the Chicago shelters and then are followed after leaving the shelters for a time period of 6months to 1 year allowing group and individual therapy sessions.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? N/A
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Women can work through the mental and emotional issues stemming from the migration process. Traumas vary from Rape to Mental abuse to loss of loved ones, to being separated from loved ones, to prolonged living conditions, as well as the physical nature of the trip.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Illinois Venezuelan Alliance is administering the help and organizing the groups for therapy
