### **Project Description**

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1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? A total of \$5,300 was sent to the Wildfire Disaster Relief Fund of Rotary District 5280.

When (dates) and where (city, state and country) did project activities take place?

The initial \$3,300 was a combination of \$1,650 member donations and \$1,650 match from the Frontier Rotary Charitable Fund. These funds were sent to District 5280 on February 13, 2025. The \$1,000 District 5495 grant along with our \$1,000 match was mailed to District 5280 on March 31, 2025.

Who were the beneficiaries? Victims of the southern California wildfires that occurred January 7 – 31, 2025. Right from the start, District 5280 provided hot meals for students unable to attend school in the early days of the disaster, provided hygiene kits for exhausted first responders, ensured that city/county linemen had nourishment and essentials as they were restoring power and communications, and provided rental assistance to stricken families.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Rotarians from virtually all 67 clubs of District 5280 have participated in one fashion or another.
3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotarians and Rotaractors have conducted service projects for disaster victims in addition to their cash donations. Rotarians have offered housing support by providing their own properties for rent or sale. They have volunteered at Evacuation Centers as well as Animal Shelters.

How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Non-Rotarians impacted by the Palisades, Hurst, Eaton and Altadena Fires have benefitted by donations to D5280's relief fund.

4. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? District 5280 is working with neighboring District 5300 in providing relief at many levels. Also, D5280 provided grants to the American Red Cross, LA Regional Food Bank, California Fire Foundation and the Upper Ojai Relief.
