

What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Arlington North West Rotary gives 4 - \$2000 scholarships to graduating Seniors at Martin High School in Arlington Texas. Throughout the school year September to April) 2 Senior students of the Month are selected by the Staff and Administrators at Maritn High School, then those 2 students attend one of our weekly meetings and give a talk about there aspirations, goals and future plans for college. Members of our scholarship committee take notes and after all 8 have come, the committee meet after the April Students spoke to discuss the 8 students and selected 4 to receive our scholarships. On May 19th, 3 members of Arlington North West Rotary attended the Martin High School Awards ceremony to present the school with a check for \$8,000 for the scholarships and award the students certificates of the scholarship. 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 8 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Each month (September through April) members of the scholarship committee listened to the students talks and took notes on the scholarship judging form. After the April Seniors of the month spoke the members of the Scholarship committee meet to discuss the ranking of the 16 talks and decided of the 4 scholarship recipients. Then 3 members of the club, the President, the immediate Past President and Chair of the Scholarship committee attended the awards ceremony at the High School to present the scholarships to the winners. 4. How many Non-Rotarians participated in the project? 3 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The scholarships allow the

recipients to expand their education beyond high school and help them achieve college degrees

and hopefully comeback to Arlington and become leaders in the community and future Rotarians.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Martin High School, the principle, assistant principles and team leads select 2 Seniors each month to recognize and recommend for a possible scholarship. The High School then once they receive proof/verification from the student's college of their enrollment, the scholarship money is sent to the college directly to pay tuition.
