4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 9 middle school students and their 18 parents plus a school full of students whose culture will be changed by so many newly empowered student leaders who will have attended Junior RYLA.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Year after year we see how students change from the impact of RYLA. After last year's Junior RYLA, parents raved about how their children were empowered, brave, confident...even saying they got their child back because they had previously become withdrawn. We develop our future school and community leaders with our RYLA camps.

The Middle School counselor and principal went to teachers for nominations, they sent invitations letting students and parents know the student had been nominated and encouraging them to apply and they attended the parent/student info night to encourage attendance at Junior RYLA and promote the program.




