3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

MBSR Rotary members will team up with the schoolteachers to provide the students with a presentation regarding the importance of water on our planet. "Water is life" "Agua es Vida". The event will be on Friday April 24,2026 at the school library. MBSR Rotary members will be coming to the school to work with the children and help install the water dispensers at the appropriate classroom locations. Every student will be gifted a water bottle to use during school hours. The bottles will be kept in the classrooms to prevent the children carrying them or losing them. The ECO Garden upkeep and new planting will be conducted also by MBSR members, kids and parents. We are attending and running on Saturday April 25th RYLA event at the Red Cross located in Tijuana.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

The school project will benefit 350 students from 6-13 years of age.
The RYLA project will be benefiting 90 young adults from 19-25 years of age.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

At school we want to promote health and appreciation for water to young children. At the RYLA event we want to promote education practices to improve "emergency responsive attitudes" during emergency calls at the Red Cross.
