The Rotary Club of Manta, in Ecuador, will administer the project.


The city of Manta will host the project.



SHEKINAH FOUNDATION

Created 25 years ago, located in the city of Manta, Manabí province, its corporate purpose as a non-governmental entity is to preserve vulnerable rights and restore the rights of boys, girls, adolescents at risk within the canton, province and country in Generally, it houses minors in a vulnerable state.

While they remain sheltered they receive food, clothing, education and the assistance of the personnel in their care.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

- Train in the craft of Sewing and Dressmaking as a tool for the support of vulnerable women and men, who do not have formal income, to contribute to family well-being.
- Work in the process of sustainable autonomy with adolescents from the age of 14 to 17 years 11 months, as a resource for their retirement from the foundation at 18 years of age.








PROJECT BENEFICIARIES

They will benefit: Directly 50 people. Indirectly 25 people with a multiplier effect to 125 people.

25 women and men from the ages of 14 to 17 years 11 months of age, who are sheltered in the Shekinah foundation that is the Legal Representative of the young people sheltered.

25 Adult women, mothers of foster youth, to improve their income and contribute to family well-being = 125 people indirectly.

PROCESS USED TO DETERMINATE NECESSITIES

<u>Community meetings:</u> with representatives of the Shekinah Foundation and members of the Rotary Club of Manta (between August, September and October 2021) to discuss financial concerns and challenges affecting their areas;

<u>Group interviews:</u> Several groups of mothers affected by the economic crisis were interviewed in their homes.

<u>Asset inventory:</u> They have 7 sewing machines: 5 domestic straight machines, 1 industrial straight machine and 1 domestic overlock machine.

Since 2019, they have 15 young people with sewing skills, who received intensive training from a group of women volunteers from the Church of Missouri-USA, they made sets of sheets, fabric shower curtains, shorts, blouses and backpacks.







COMMUNITY NEEDS

- Purchase of all the necessary equipment to achieve industrialized clothing.
- Basic technical training in clothing for 40 women and 10 men for 3 months and then they will have advanced technical training for 6 months.
- Training focused on BEING as a person who has capacities, aptitudes, attitudes, identity, training in leadership, teamwork, values and human development.
- Entrepreneurship training, based on the CANVAS business model (Entrepreneurship Program), advice, administrative and commercial support as a business foundation.
- Training program in productive skills of textile manufacturing of uniforms for the fish packing companies that exist in Manta, white goods (sheets, tablecloths, pillowcases, etc.), sportswear, uniforms for schools and educational institutes.
