SEWING WORKSHOP "SEMILLERO DE ESPERANZA"

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- The 14-year-old and 17-year-old 11-month-old from the Shekinah Foundation have sewing skills.
- Provide training in an autonomy project, for emancipation at 18 years of age, who must leave their permanent life in the Foundation and be inserted into society with a working knowledge, which will allow them to improve their quality of life in the future.
- The project has the support of the cantonal GAD.
- Mothers of families will participate and will be an active part in the training in the Sewing Workshop.
- All those trained have equitable functions and earnings, it will allow government organizations to have legal requirements for their insertion in banking, social security and the internal income system, to guarantee its proper functioning, complying with all that it demands. .
- Preventive maintenance of all equipment and tools in the clothing workshop
- The project is carried out by working with the community that it supports with work and cleaning mingas to support the management of the Rotary Club.

AREA OF INTEREST: ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE COMMUNITY

BENEFITED POPULATION

THE SHEKINAH FOUNDATION, is legally constituted since February 1996, located in the Manta canton, Manabí province, whose corporate purpose as a non-governmental entity is to preserve vulnerable rights and restore the rights of children, adolescents at risk within of the canton, province and the country in general. It is located in Barrio Cristo Rey, in the center of the city of Manta.

50 people will be benefited directly, 25 people with a multiplier effect to 125 people indirectly.

25 women and men from the ages of 14 to 17 years 11 months of age, who are sheltered in the Shekinah foundation that is the Legal Representative of the young people sheltered.

25 Adult women, mothers of foster youth, to improve their income and contribute to family well-being.





While they remain sheltered they receive food, clothing, education and the assistance of the personnel in their care.

NEED:

- Acquisition of all the equipment required to achieve quality industrialized clothing, from cutting, manufacturing, ironing and quality control.
- A basic technical training program for 40 women and 10 men for 3 months and then they will have advanced technical training for 6 months.
- Training focused on the BEING as a person who has capacities, aptitudes, attitudes, identity, training in leadership, teamwork, values and human development.
- Entrepreneurship training, based on the CANVAS business model (Entrepreneurship Program), advice and administrative and commercial support as a business foundation.
- Program of training in productive skills aimed at women and men between 14 and 17 years of age 11 months in a vulnerable condition so that they can develop a job competence or an enterprise. The training topics are: textile manufacturing, that is, uniforms for fish packing companies, white goods (sheets, tablecloths, pillowcases, etc.), sportswear, uniforms for schools and educational institutes.
