Technology as Educational Alternative to Change Lives



Small communities, BIG DREAMS

With the COVID-19 pandemia, the small communities of Saucillo, El fuerte, La Joya, El Cajon, Aguacaliente were left WITHOUT TEACHERS.

- There are around 200 children and young students locate in Ocampo municipality, close to the Sierra Tarahumara, This small communities has a big challenge because another factor is the location of these communities close to the critical insecurity zone, affects the support they can receive from the government itself.
- In order to continue with their education program in a distance mode, (satellite internet) we promote to equip a computer classroom so they can finally continue with their education. Also in alliance with PAZ Y CONVIVENCIA we will bring a program to develop life skills in the children and young students.
- The project is to equip with 30 computers with desks, installation, a server and entire year program with a psychologist and methodology to support these communities.
- The cost estimated of the project is \$62,500 USD



General objective:

Provide access to technology as well psychological with equipment and computer classes to children and teenagers in 5 priority communities of the municipality of Ocampo, in order to reduce risk factors and develop life skills for 180 children and young students, for 2023 school period.

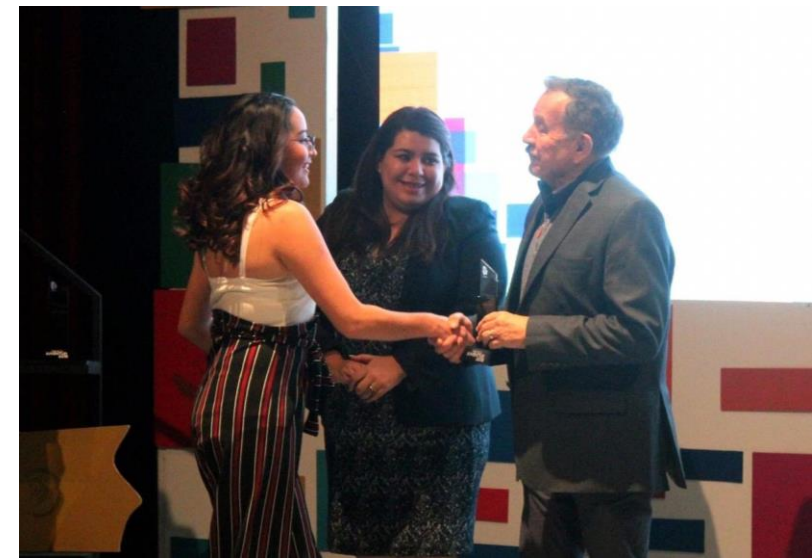
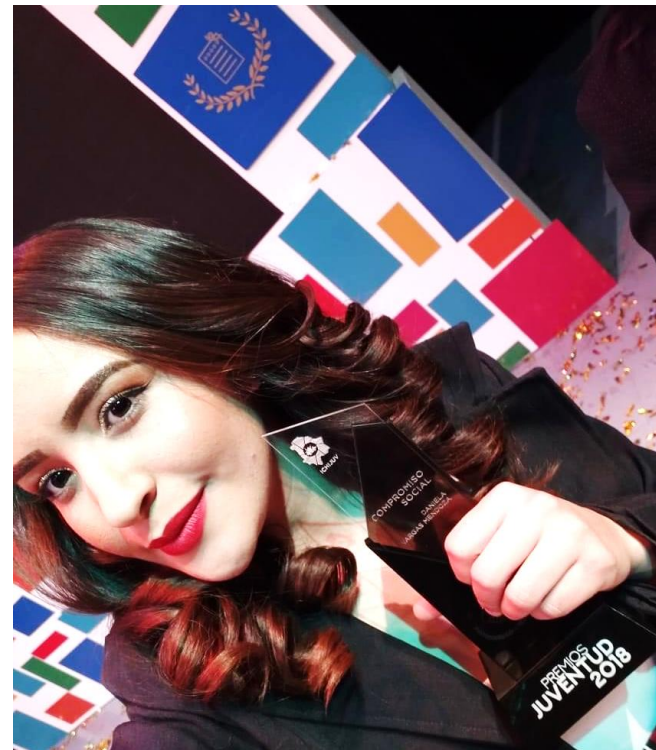


Daniela Vargas

Objetives

1. Provide computer classes and integration of technology to educational training by integrating 10 hours per week in class sessions.
2. In alliance with PAZ Y CONVIVENCIA, a follow-up program with psychological support, to detect risk factors to convert them into protective factors through psychological care, skills development for life as well as implementing a life project during this intervention for the school year.

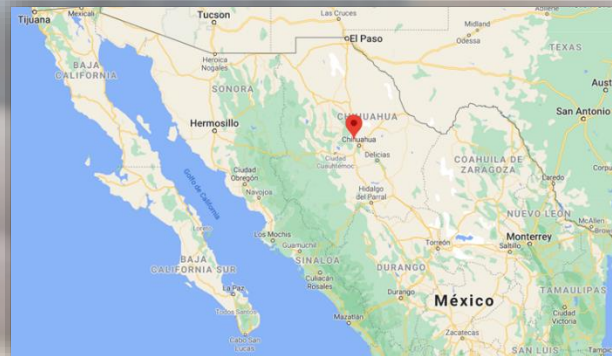
