

**MINUTES OF MIGORI COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS MEETING HELD ON 18TH
NOVEMBER 2022 AT HERITAGE ANNEX AS FROM 9:00 AM**

MIN 01/11/22: Opening

The meeting was opened with a word of prayer from Belinda Anyango. The Chief Executive Officer of Rieko Kenya, Mr. Kabaka then gave an opening remark. He appreciated the congregation for a meeting well attended and further led the self-introduction of all stakeholders.

Mr. Kabaka appreciated the importance of bi-annual stakeholders meeting. It was noted that these meetings help to review progress of interventions geared towards supporting the poor, disadvantaged and vulnerable communities by Rieko Kenya and other development actors. Secondly, the meetings were to help identify most felt community needs and finally to propose most impactful interventions. There was also an update on the progress of the projects undertaken in the past 6 months.

MIN 02/11/22: Reading and Confirmation of Previous Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed as the true position. As there were no matters arising, the meeting proceeded to the next agenda.

MIN 03/11/22: Community Needs Identification

1. Unemployment and Poverty among teenage mothers, adolescent girls, and youth

The meeting discussed insurmountable and severe problems affecting the teenage mothers, adolescent girls, and youth. The stakeholders and community representatives who spoke in the meeting mentioned that the worst problem is the vulnerability of women, adolescent girls, and youth that are highly stricken by poverty. Presentations from different stakeholders said that the economic severity facing the women and youth was worsened by the effects of COVID-19. It was identified that low income is due to limited opportunities, cultural alienation characterized by early marriages and poor preference to education and HIV/AIDS infections along Lake Victoria. It was discussed that the situation is dire and resulting into hopelessness among the affected women and youth.



2. Water shortage

The meeting identified lack of clean and safe water as the second problem in order of priority. It was discussed that sustainable access to safe water in the region is estimated to be less than 5%. Many of the water points have since dried up. Most villages experiences comparatively harsher climatic conditions. Women and children spends an average of 3-4 hours/day to fetch dirty water for drinking and domestic purposes from the existing sources. The areas identified are mostly in Nyatike, Suna-West and Suna-East, Kuria-West, and Kuria-East Sub-Counties.

MIN 04/11/22: Interventions/Action Plans and Way Forward

The stakeholders unanimously agreed that there is urgent need to address the hopelessness that are rocking and wrecking the living standards of teenage mothers, adolescent girls, and youth. The meeting of stakeholders requested Rieko Kenya and other stakeholders to look for possible solutions to economically empower the affected population. It was mentioned that the easiest and meaningful way of addressing their economic challenges is through equipping them with employable vocational skills. Further, it was discussed that there are substantial employment opportunities for women especially in the areas of cosmetology, tailoring, hospitality, and event management. Rieko Kenya was mandated to source possible partnerships, linkages and networks that will support the vulnerable women and youth, ensuring that they become economically self-reliant.

Secondly, in lack of clean and safe water, the meeting tasked Rieko Kenya to map-out development partners that are working on water supply. It was recommended that there is need to provide and supply piped water which is clean and safe for domestic use. Some suggestions made were to drill and equip boreholes, install roof catchment tanks for water harvesting in schools and abstract and treat water for distribution from Lake Victoria.

MIN 05/11/22: AOB and Conclusion

Rieko Kenya CEO thanked everyone for attending the meeting and invited any other issues for discussion. However, since there were no further issues to be discussed, the chairperson adjourned the meeting at 02:00 PM
