





# City of Chernihiv - Solar for Critical Infrastructure Project and Solar Jobs for Veterans Pilot

The following is an overview of a public/private initiative now underway between the U.S. government; the municipality of Chernihiv, Ukraine; Rotary Clubs of Kyiv-Capital and Babcock Ranch, FL, Rotary International; and key educational institutions, businesses and NGOs in Ukraine. The Rotary team members are moving forward with a Rotary Global Grant application to support the work.

## **Global Grant Purpose**

- Harden critical infrastructure in Chernihiv by supporting a demonstration project to install solar on two hospitals and two schools/shelters in the City of Chernihiv. Rotary Club is working with the <u>Net Zero World Initiative</u>, a flagship international initiative of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), implemented by DOE's national laboratories, led by the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (<u>NREL</u>). NZW works closely with the Ministry of Energy of Ukraine.
- 2. Increase career pathways for Ukrainians—especially veterans—by promoting certification in a broad array of solar job categories in cooperation with several Ukrainian polytechnic institutes and active solar installation businesses.
- 3. Promote technology transfer by publicizing NREL's citywide engineering analysis of solar viability for all critical infrastructure buildings in Chernihiv. This supports the Ukraine Government's goal to transition to 25% renewable energy by 2030.
