EL PORVENIR, SUPE DISTRICT, PERU

The community of El Porvenir installed their first water project in 2003



This system continues to function optimally, currently delivering potable water to approx. 2000 residents



The community has now grown considerably – the current population is close to 3000 inhabitants



This project will expand the existing water system and use solar power to pump additional water to an elevated reservoir, from where the water will flow to 265 new homes



The community will contribute hundreds of hours of labour to dig the trenches for the water pipes.



After chlorination, each of the 256 additional households in El Porvenir will be supplied with gravityfed water to a faucet at the home



Les Ailes de L'Esperance – our Service Provider



This Montreal-based NGO has been working in Peru over the past 50 years.

They have completed several hundred water projects on the coast, in the Andes, and in the Amazon basin of Peru.

Since 2000, Les Ailes has installed approx. 30 water projects near Barranca, all of which are currently still functioning. Tens of thousands of people now have clean water.

All water projects are only undertaken if there is a local water committee composed of at least 50% women from the community.

All community members are given training on hygiene and the proper use of potable water.

The community will take ownership of the project by contributing many hours of unskilled labour toward the project and having a trained water committee.



Funding for the El Porvenir water project The Castlegar Rotary club will be the International Club The Huacho Rotary club will be the Host Club

Total cost: \$128,600.00 US

The Montreal Rotary Club will contribute 50% of total funds

The Castlegar Rotary Club is responsible for raising 50% of funds through cash contributions from our District clubs, matching DDF grants and matching grants from the Global Fund.
